COVID Update

We have reached the end of the year with no COVID cases! I feel like that's nothing short of a miracle given what is going on in the world around us at the minute. Again, a big thank you to the Keyham Team and to all of you for your trust and support. We will continue to work hard in 2021 to honour the trust you put in us to keep the wellbeing and safety of your children as our primary concern.

COVID Reminder

It is vital that you get a test and isolate in the event of your child showing <u>any</u> <u>one</u> of the 3 symptoms:

- A temperature;
- A new continuous cough lasting more than an hour, or 3 coughing episodes in a 24 hour period;
- A loss of sense of taste or smell.

COVID Holidays Track and Trace To help us manage the situation into the holidays, please note the following advice from the DfE:

Where a pupil or staff member tests positive for coronavirus (COVID-19), having developed symptoms **more than 48 hours since being in school**, the school should **not be contacted**. Parents and carers should follow contact tracing instructions provided by NHS Test and Trace.

E.g. - Children developing symptoms after 3.30pm on Sunday 20th December.

For the first 6 days after teaching ends, if a pupil or staff member tests positive for coronavirus (COVID-19), having developed symptoms **within 48 hours of being in school**, the school is asked to assist in identifying close contacts and advising self-isolation, as the individual may have been infectious whilst in school.

Please inform Miss Riley (rriley@keyhambarton.plymouth.sch.uk) if your child develops symptoms between 3.15pm on Friday 18th and Sunday 20th December and tests

positive for COVID-19.
