Dear School Family,

COVID Reminder

The three key symptoms to watch out for are:

- A high temperature;
- A loss of sense of smell or taste
- A new, continuous cough lasting more than an hour, or 3 coughing fits in a 24 hour period.

If a child displays any of the above, we are directed to call you immediately and for you to pick them up. If a member of your household is symptomatic, you need to isolate for 10 days or until you have received a negative test result.

You do not need to keep children home for any other symptoms unless you normally would.

Google Classrooms

In the event of being symptomatic or awaiting a test result, every class will be posting the same learning they are doing in class on Google Classrooms. All children have logins to the classrooms and to IXL. We would very strongly recommend that your children are accessing our online provision if they can't be in school, as it is crucial that we work together to help them keep up!

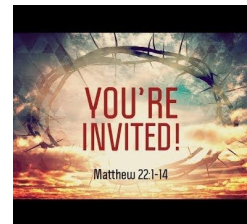
You will need to sign up for clubs by emailing the office. All sports clubs are free for this term only.
