# WORSHIP AND LITURGY Grow in Love



In this week's Gospel, some people come and ask the disciples if they can see Jesus. In response to this request, Jesus makes an important speech. He knows that soon he will have to die, but Jesus wants everyone to understand that this is the reason he is here. By dying, he will bring life and hope into the world and good will come from this.

Jesus explains what he means using a seed. He says that when a grain of wheat falls on the ground, it dies, but then because one plant has died, lots of other wheat plants can grow.

Jesus teaches us that we might have to give up some things if we are going to follow in his footsteps and put other people before ourselves, but if we do that, we will find great happiness in being able to grow in love for others.

### **Action**

How can we grow in love for others? Spring is a beautiful time of year, where all life grows and we see seeds sprouting and daffodils and bluebells all around.
